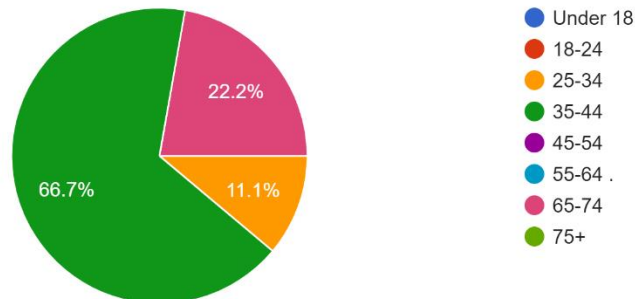


Review of church services (community perspective)

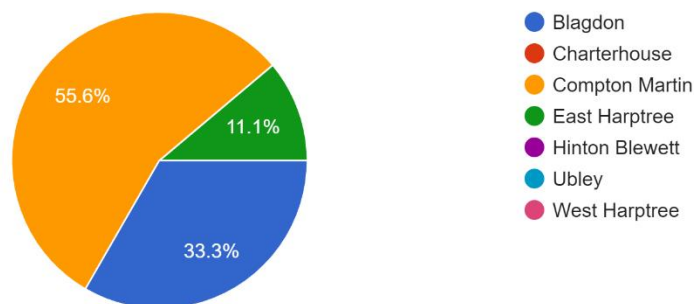
1. What age group are you in?

9 responses

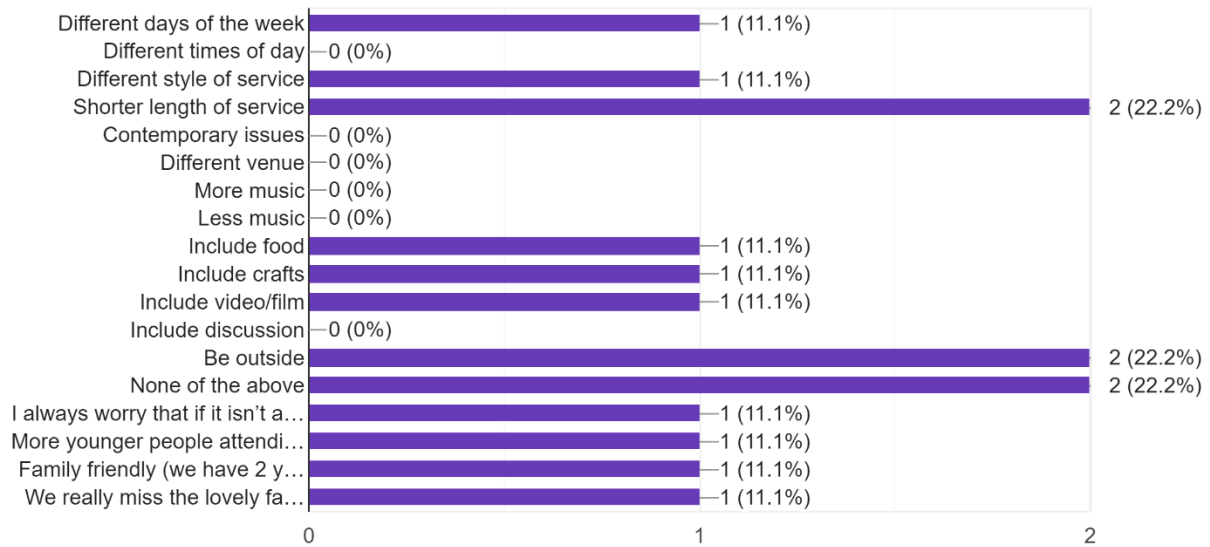


3. Have you attended any church services in the last 18 months? If so what kind of service(s)? 9 responses
